"Two-thirds of Kenya's electricity is generated from renewable or clean energy sources. Of this, wind power accounts for 15 percent (435MW) while solar accounts for just under two percent of total installed capacity (51MW) with these numbers expected to continue to grow" the US International Trade Association said in a brief to American firms last year.

The existing retail tariffs were approved for application on July 2018 to cover one year (1st July 2018 - 30th June 2019). They were revised in January 2022 to allow for a 15% reduction in the end-user tariffs.

The global residential energy storage market size was valued at USD 2.69 billion in 2024 and to reach USD 4.58 billion by 2030, growing at a compound annual growth rate (CAGR) of 9.3% from 2024 to 2030.
