What is Kiribati integrated energy roadmap?

The resulting Kiribati Integrated Energy Roadmap (KIER) highlights key challenges and presents solutions to make Kiribati's entire energy sector cleaner and more cost effective. As a small, remote island state, Kiribati is highly dependent on imported energy supply. Electricity is one of the government's largest expenditures.

Does Kiribati need electricity?

As a small, remote island state, Kiribati is highly dependent on imported energy supply. Electricity is one of the government's largest expenditures. Yet the current fossil fuel-based power system is inadequate to meet future demand.

Who generates electricity in Kiribati?

Sector context. Grid-connected electricity in Kiribati's capital, South Tarawa, is generated 4. and distributed by the Public Utilities Board (PUB), a state-owned electricity and water utility.

Why is electricity so expensive in Kiribati?

Of the 7,877 households in South Tarawa (44% of total households in Kiribati), 72.4% are connected to grid electricity. Access is largely for lighting, and that lighting is often insufficient, inefficient, and expensive. The high electricity cost has suppressed demand and has hindered growth in the commercial and tourism sectors.

How many people live in Kiribati?

Half of Kiribati's population of 115,847 live in the capital, South Tarawa, which has a land area of only 16 km² (population density of over 3,600 per km²). Of the 7,877 households in South Tarawa (44% of total households in Kiribati), 72.4% are connected to grid electricity.

How will Kiribati's water crisis affect the community?

There will be impacts on one communal water well, and over 600 trees. Consultations were conducted with affected persons and nearby communities. A Resettlement Plan has been prepared in compliance with the SPS and laws of Kiribati.

The present work is an analytical study for the Kiribati grid system and is focused on Tarawa atoll. Kiribati, a PIC, is one of the World's Least Developed Countries (LDC) according to the United Nations classification. Kiribati relies almost entirely on imported fuels for its power generation and transportation requirements.

The Kiribati Integrated Energy Roadmap (KIER) 2017-2025 (International Renewable Energy Agency, 2017) states the objective to reach a rate of 100 per cent by 2025. However, due to a slower rate of electrification since COVID-19, it is expected that the 100 per cent access rate will be achieved in 2030.
