Is energy storage a key initiative in Malaysia?

Recognizing the intermittent nature of renewable energy, particularly in Malaysia, the development of energy storage, especially BESS, is considered essential, and NETR identifies BESS as a key initiative.

How do energy subsidies work in Malaysia?

In Malaysia, energy subsidies are intended as a mechanism to keep energy affordable for its citizens. Subsidies do this directly, by enabling consumers to pay less for fuel, and indirectly, by making the goods and services that use subsidized fuel (such as public transport) cheaper by reducing input costs.

Why is battery storage important in Malaysia?

The integration of battery storage is becoming increasingly essential as Malaysia seeks to leverage more renewable energy sources, particularly solar power. Solar energy's variability, dependent on weather conditions, necessitates reliable storage solutions to ensure a consistent electricity supply during periods of low or no sunlight.

Why is Malaysia reducing fuel subsidies?

There is also a strong environmental reason for reducing fuel subsidies, given that they encourage wasteful consumption and make it more difficult for cleaner types of energy to compete. The Malaysian government has recognized these problems and emphasized energy subsidy reform in its national development strategies.

Is transport fuel subsidized in Malaysia?

Transport fuel has been subsidized in Malaysia since 1983 and is now an intensely political issue. In 2011, more than 10 per cent of the government's operating expenditure was spent on fuel subsidies. This accounted for more than 43 per cent of its gross development expenditure (Ilias, Lankanathan & Poh, 2012).

How much solar storage is needed in Malaysia?

In a recent interview, outgoing TNB president and CEO Datuk Seri Baharin Din highlighted the substantial storage requirements, estimating that around 500 MW of storage capacity would be needed for every 1 GW of solar capacity. This underscores the scale of investment required to fully integrate renewable energy into Malaysia's energy mix.
