Where will a battery energy storage system be built in New York?

The New York State Public Service Commission (PSC) gave its approval earlier this month for the battery energy storage system (BESS) to be built in Brookhaven, a town in New York's Suffolk County by Holtsville Energy Storage.

What is New York state's energy storage goal?

This Order formally expands the State's goal to 6,000 Megawatts of energy storage to be installed by 2030, and authorized funds for NYSEERDA to support 200 Megawatts of new residential-scale solar, 1,500 Megawatts of new commercial and community-scale energy storage, and 3,000 Megawatts of new large-scale storage.

What is New York's energy storage roadmap?

The Roadmap proposed a comprehensive set of recommendations to expand New York's energy storage programs to cost-effectively unlock the rapid growth of renewable energy across the State and bolster grid reliability and customer resilience.

How will energy storage impact New York?

What is NYCIDA's largest battery energy storage project?
