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4. Energy security. Energy is not only an economic issue, but has also become a strategic and security concern, especially in current geopolitical situation. A cohesive, well-functioning energy market and the freedom to choose between suppliers will increase open competition, ensure that the region is better supplied, and boost energy security.

According to Antti Tooming, Undersecretary of the Nuclear Energy Working Group, Undersecretary-General of the Ministry of Climate, nuclear energy has proven itself in many countries around the world. "Other energy has the potential to ensure a stable energy supply in Estonia for future generations."

This fits in with Estonia's ambitious goal of using only 100% renewable energy by 2030 at the latest. In 2022, Hydrogen Valley Estonia formulated a plan to develop the world's first national hydrogen ecosystem, and the first production units, distribution solutions and applications will be created within the next six years.

Energiasalv is not the only pumped hydro energy storage project that Estonia is looking to add. Last year, Energy-Storage.news reported on a 2 25MW unit being planned by state-owned company Eesti Energia in Ida-Virumaa, on the other side of the country. That project is slated for completion by 2025-26, and would also mostly be underground.

Estonia received 23 applications in April for a EUR1.5 billion EU call for hydrogen projects.
