

Leave an uninterruptible power supply in the computer room

What is an uninterruptible power supply (UPS)?

by Daniel P. Dern - The Uninterruptible Power Supply (UPS) you've gotten (see my previous tip on how to choose a desktop UPS) to protect your computer, data, and ability to keep working or shut down in an order fashion, doesn't need a lot of attention.

Why do we need an uninterruptible power supply?

What happens if a power supply is interrupted?

Depending on the device and the task being performed, even a brief interruption can lead to undesirable consequences such as defects or loss of data. Even with an uninterruptible power supply, some solutions may result in a short interruption of the power supply. However, this is only a few milliseconds.

What should I do if my ups won't turn on?

- o Refrain from placing heavy objects on the UPS. Protect it from physical damage by avoiding placing heavy items on top of it.
- o Never plug the unit into itself. Doing this can cause power fluctuations, prompt the UPS to revert to battery power, cycle between the battery and normal operation, and spark inverter compatibility issues.

Should I Turn my Computer off during a brownout?

If brownouts happen frequently in your area, you should consider investing in an uninterruptible power supply (UPS). Therefore, you should leave the computer turned off when you do not plan on using it for a fairly long time or when lightning is in the area. Power consumption is also a consideration.

What happens if the mains supply is interrupted?

If the mains supply is interrupted or the current values are above or below the permissible tolerance range, the UPS immediately supplies the connected, sensitive systems with current or protects them against overvoltages. The UPS differs from a general backup power supply (AEV) in that it can supply critical loads immediately.
