The loss of output over time, called degradation, typically lands at about 0.5% each year, according to the National Renewable Energy Laboratory (NREL). Manufacturers typically consider 25 to 30 years a point at which enough degradation has occurred where it may be time to consider replacing a panel.

What is the total degradation of Tier 1 solar panels over 25 years?

Over 25 years, your panels will operate at 93.04% of their original capacity in 2045. For most Tier 1 solar panels, the degradation rate is .30% meaning that each year, the panels performance is reduced by .30%.

How long does a solar module warranty last?

Until this year, the standard performance warranty offered by top tier solar module makers was a guarantee of 25 years of energy production at 80% or higher of their stated output. The product (in terms of materials and workmanship) warranty was a guarantee for 10 years in most cases.
