

Luxembourg solar energy storage project

How many solar projects has Luxembourg selected?

Luxembourg has selected 75 solar projects in the nation's first procurement exercise for self-consumption. It will launch a second tender in July. From pv magazine France Luxembourg's Ministry of Economy and Ministry of Energy have chosen 85 projects totaling 43.3 MW in the country's inaugural solar self-consumption tender.

Does Luxembourg need photovoltaics?

In particular, in Luxembourg, the National Energy and Climate Plan states that photovoltaics must play a central role in the energy production of Luxembourg, and that renewable "green hydrogen" is urgently needed as a fuel in sectors (e.g., heavy transportation) where electrification is not viable.

What is the energy storage project in Belgium?

The main energy storage project in Belgium is the construction and operation of an offshore "energy atoll" (essentially a manmade offshore pumped-storage facility), for which the Electricity Act has been modified in 2014 (see below), in order to support offshore wind-generated electricity production.

When will Luxembourg launch a second solar tender?

The ministry plans to launch the second tender of this kind in July. As of the end of 2022, Luxembourg had approximately 319 MW of installed PV capacity, with around 42 MW of new solar additions last year, according to the International Renewable Energy Agency. How much does a solar project cost?

The tender encompassed three project categories: installations ranging from 30 kW to 200 kW, with a subsidy ceiling of EUR810/kW; arrays with an installed power of 200 kW to 500 kW, with a subsidy ceiling of EUR610/kW; and PV systems with a capacity between 500 kW and 5 MW, with a subsidy ceiling of EUR530/kW.
