



Mauritania installs solar power system

How many solar panels does Mauritania produce a year?

The facility is responsible for 10% of Mauritania's grid capacity. It generates 25,409 megawatt-hours of renewable electricity per year and displaces approximately 21,225 tons of CO₂. The plant's almost 30,000 solar panels, manufactured by Masdar PV, provide electricity to more than 10,000 houses in Nouakchott.

Who installed the solar PV farm in Mauritius?

Siemens France installed the solar PV farm in Mauritius. The finance minister also announced plans to increase the capacity of the solar PV farm at Henrietta from 2 MW to 10 MW; the CEB subsequently launched a tender for an 8MW ac solar PV farm project valued at \$8 million.

The Sheikh Zayed Solar Power Plant in Nouakchott, the capital of the Islamic Republic of Mauritania, is a 15-megawatt solar installation. It is one of Africa's largest solar power facilities and the country's first utility-scale facility. The facility is responsible for 10% of Mauritania's grid capacity.

What is Masdar doing in Mauritania?

The power plant is one of numerous worldwide initiatives supported by Masdar. Mauritanian utility (SOMELEC) issued a request for proposals, and the Vergnet-ABC Diesel pool was chosen to deliver the hybrid power plant project in Mauritania. It will be the first of its kind in the sub-region of West Africa.

How many solar panels are there in Nouakchott?

The plant's almost 30,000 solar panels, manufactured by Masdar PV, provide electricity to more than 10,000 houses in Nouakchott. The plant has produced more energy than expected, resulting in significant savings and accounting for an annual increase in demand.

What is the Sahel Solar Initiative?

The board gave their approval on July 1, 2021. In terms of objectives, the initiative aims to stretch across the Sahel region, connecting 250 million people with electricity by tapping into the region's abundant solar resources.

The plant has supplied 10% of the energy production in the country in 2019. Toujounine large-scale solar farm substitutes grid electricity by clean and renewable energy and cutting down GHG emissions from baseline fossil fuel intensive grid mix (mostly gasoil/fuel oil). It serves as a paving example of renewable energy development in Mauritania.

By 2022, the largest solar power plant in the country already supplied over 12% of Nouakchott's energy needs, according to Zaied, the young manager of the plant. This energy production comes at a lower cost compared to fossil fuel energy, making it a more affordable option for households.

The 76.3kWp solar carport consists of 448 solar modules that is predicted to generate 55.7MWh of electricity per year - enough to power 20 local homes. Through the associated feed-in tariff and reduced energy costs, Nottingham City Council is hoping to generate over £10,000 of benefit every year it operates.

Mauritania currently has 13 operational solar farms, with biggest ones being: Sheikh Zayed Solar Power Plant (15 MW), Toujounine Solar Plant (50 MW) and Masdar Solar Network (16.6 MW). The Mauritania-Mali Electricity Interconnection Project, part of the Desert to Power initiative, is set to add two more solar plants of 50 MW each.

The findings of this study indicate that a significant portion of Mauritania's land area is highly suitable for solar PV and wind development, with a maximum development potential of approximately 457.9 gigawatts (GW) and 47 GW for solar PV and wind projects, respectively.

In other words, about 2.6 million out of a total population of 4 million people lack access to electricity. In 2018, the installed generation capacity was 500 MW, with a renewable energy (hydro, solar and wind) share of 41%. Given the 100 MW of wind power under construction, the share of renewable energy in the energy mix will soon be about 50%.
