

Module prices and PV investment returns

Why are PV module prices falling?

Photovoltaic (PV) module prices are a key metric for PV project development and growth of the PV industry. The general trend of global PV module pricing has been a rapid and steep decline-- an order of magnitude over the past 10 years (Mints April 2019)--enabled by economies of scale as well as manufacturing and technology improvements.

When will PV module prices rise?

As a result, module prices will likely rise moderately but steadily until at least early next quarter. This outlook reflects delays in deliveries from major brands, with restocking for mid-sized PV systems not expected until April or May.

How much does a PV module cost in Europe?

It noted an increase in commercial PV material recyclers and equipment providers from 25 companies in 2017 to 177 companies this year. Each company reported a recycling volume ranging from 1,000 tons per year to 50,000+tons per year. By August, module prices in Europe dropped to EUR0.113/Wp for mono n-type and EUR0.116/Wp for bifacial n-type products.

Will rising module prices reverse the low-price phase?

Rising module prices may push manufacturers to invest in higher-quality raw materials, reversing the quality decline seen during the recent low-price phase. Modules sold in bulk to Europe often lacked performance reliability, particularly in top-tier categories, unless buyers secured specific quality agreements.

Are PV systems a good investment?

In a future market with dynamic tariffs and bidirectional charging, PV systems are more than just add-ons - they are essential for maximizing self-sufficiency. However, module price alone is becoming less relevant to overall system economics. Long-term reliability matters more, as maintenance or replacement costs can erode investment returns.

Are module prices going up?
