What is a good compromise for RV inverter power?

A good compromise for RV inverter power is to install a 30 amp receptacle on the outside of your RV and then connect it to the output of the RV inverter. When you want inverter power, you just unplug the RV from shore power and plug it into the new 30 amp receptacle.

Should I Turn my RV inverter on or off?

No. You should turn your RV inverter off when not in use. If you leave it on, it will continue to drain power from the battery even when none of your appliances is in use. In other words, leaving the inverter on all the time will drain your battery faster. Can I Drive My RV With the Inverter On? Yes, you can drive your RV with your inverter on.
