

Mozambique 170 MW of solar energy

Which zone has the highest solar power potential in Mozambique?

The zones marked in the darkest shades show the highest potential. By the end of 2022, there is a total of 125 MW of solar power plants (under a public-private partnership (PPP)) developed in Mozambique, of which 60 MW are already connected to the national grid: Projects Mocuba and Metoro.

What is PV power potential in Mozambique?

The PV power potential map developed by the World Bank shows the potential for PV power projects in Mozambique on a scale of a yearly total specific PV power output of 1,534 to 1,753 kWh/kWp. The zones marked in the darkest shade show the highest potential.

What is the biomass potential of Mozambique?

Overall, Mozambique has a rich biomass potential of over 2 GW. Charcoal and firewood are important fuels for cooking energy purposes in Mozambique, as well as in other countries in southern Africa.

Does Mozambique have wind power?

Mozambique has a potential wind capacity of 4.5 GW, of which about 25% has potential for immediate connection to the existing grid. The provinces with the most potential are Tete, Maputo, Sofala, Gaza, and Inhambane.

How many MW in Mozambique in 2022?

In 2022, 60 MW were in operation and an additional 15 MW were under construction. 310 MW projects are in pre-feasibility phase and tenders amounting to 140 MW was launched by Mozambique's renewable energy auctions program: PROLER, which assists Mozambique's national utility, EDM, with calls for tenders.

Is Mozambique a good place to invest in solar energy?

Mozambique has an abundant and unexploited solar resource which could be harnessed for utility scale as well as residential PV for both on/off grid electrification. The following map shows the global horizontal irradiation profile of Mozambique which varies between 1,785 and 2,206 kWh/m²/year.

The country's renewable energy potential is immense, with solar, wind, hydro, and biomass resources all available in abundance. According to the World Bank, Mozambique has an estimated 23,000 MW of hydropower potential, 2,700 MW of wind power potential, and a solar irradiation of 2,100 kWh/m²/year, which is one of the highest in the region.

Mozambique's Energy Regulatory Authority (ARENE) has launched a tender to select independent power producers to develop, build, operate, and maintain two 30 MW solar plants.

Currently, there is just one large-scale solar power plant under construction in Mozambique, the 40 MW

While Mozambique's renewable energy potential (indicated by the average of its wind power density at 100 meters and its solar PV potential) falls slightly below the continent's average potential (see Figure 2), the country has substantial untapped renewable resources.
