

New energy storage projects put into operation

How many kilowatts are in China's new energy storage projects?

[Photo/China Daily]The installed capacity of new energy storage projects that were put into operation during the first half of this year in China has reached 8.63 million kilowatts, equivalent to the total installed capacity of previous years in the country, according to the National Energy Administration (NEA).

How is the government advancing energy storage technologies?

The government has been continuously advancing energy storage technologies, with several compressed air energy storage, flow battery storage, and sodium-ion battery storage projects put into operation across the nation, Bian Guangqi, an NEA official, said at the conference.

How a new energy storage system is developing in China?

Dai Jianfeng, a deputy chief engineer of China Electric Power Planning and Engineering Institute, said the new energy storage in China has been developed through diverse technology routes. According to him, lithium-ion battery is still dominant at present, but the development of compressed air and liquid flow battery is accelerating.

Where are new energy storage facilities being built?

According to the administration, the northern and northwestern parts of the country have seen the fastest development of new-type energy storage facilities, accounting for over 50 percent of the newly operational energy storage installations nationwide.

What is new energy storage?

New energy storage refers to electricity storage processes that use electrochemical, compressed air, flywheel and supercapacitor systems, but not pumped hydro.

How much energy storage does China have in 2023?

By the end of 2023, China had completed and put into operation a cumulative installed capacity of new type energy storage projects reaching 31.4GW/66.9GWh, with an average storage duration of 2.1 hours. The newly added installed capacity in 2023 was approximately 22.6GW /48.7GWh, which is three times that for 2022 (7.3GW /15.9GWh).

New energy storage, or energy storage using new technologies such as lithium-ion batteries, liquid flow batteries, compressed air and mechanical energy, is an important foundation for building a new power system in China, enjoying the advantages of quick response, flexible configuration and short construction periods.

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Figures released by the National Energy Administration reveal that by the end of June, China completed and put into operation new energy storage projects with a cumulative installed capacity exceeding 17.33 gigawatts, with newly commissioned projects reaching a combined capacity of about 8.63 GW during the first half, roughly equivalent to the ...

By 2025, Guizhou aims to develop itself into an important research and development and production center for new energy power batteries and materials. Recently, China saw a diversifying new energy storage know-hows. Lithium-ion batteries accounted for 97.4 percent of China's new-type energy storage capacity at the end of 2023.

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In terms of application scenarios, independent energy storage and shared energy storage installations account for 45.3 percent, energy storage installations paired with new energy projects account for 42.8 percent, and other application scenarios account for 11.9 percent. The installed capacity of renewable energy has achieved fresh breakthroughs.

New-type of energy storage mainly refers to energy storage technologies other than pumped storage. According to the data released by the National Energy Administration in China, 13, 14 as of the end of 2023, the total installed capacity of new type of energy storage projects that have been put into operation in China has reached about 31.4 GW ...

On May 11, a sodium-ion battery energy-storage station was put into operation in Nanning, south China's Guangxi Zhuang Autonomous Region, as an initial phase of an energy-storage project. After completion, the project's overall capacity will reach a level of 100 MWh, which can meet the power demand of some 35,000 households every year.

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The northwestern regions of the country, rich in solar and wind energy resources, has become the fastest region in developing new energy storage in the country, with 10.3 million kilowatts of new energy storage installed capacity put into operation so far, accounting for 29.2 percent of the country's total, it said.

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As far as China's energy storage market is concerned, according to incomplete statistics, during January-February 2024, China put into operation 99 new energy storage projects, with a total scale of nearly 3GW, totaling 2.912GW/7.743GWh, of which due to reasons such as some of the projects were not completed at the end of 2023, the scale of the ...

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
