How do I choose the best outdoor lighting?

For optimal lighting, consider using a mix of outdoor lights around your property, including ground lights, accent lights just above eye level, and fixtures installed on the roof or above your driveway. For walkways, pathway lights on stakes are a popular choice.

What wattage should outdoor lighting be?

The recommended wattages for outdoor lighting depend on the purpose of the lighting with the maximum recommended wattage at 80. Low- and mid-range wattage lights are also beneficial for different uses.

We evaluated each product on its brightness, features, durability, and more. Our top all-around pick for an outdoor light is the Leonlite COB LED Security Light. It's a floodlight with two adjustable heads, and we love that they rotate 360 degrees, allowing you to angle the light anywhere within your yard.

Are outdoor lights wired or battery-powered?

Outdoor lights are either wired, solar-powered, or battery-operated. With the move toward LEDs and better rechargeable batteries, solar-powered lights are becoming more popular. They're ideal for remote applications and installations where you don't want to install extra wiring, but they aren't as bright as wired or battery-powered options.
