

Photovoltaic panels installed on rooftops in Dubai UAE

When will solar panels be installed in Dubai?

HH Sheikh Mohammed bin Rashid Al Maktoum, Vice President and Prime Minister of the UAE and Ruler of Dubai has called for solar panels to be installed on every roof in Dubai by 2030, with the Dubai Clean Energy Strategy 2050 having interim targets of 7% of solar power by 2020, and 25% by 2030.

Are rooftop solar panels a viable option in the Middle East?

Rooftop solar PV panels are common in a number of countries, but are only now gaining real popularity in the Middle East. Despite the sunny climates, there are still a number of barriers to switching to solar PV. Electricity tariffs are generally low, discouraging customers from switching to self-generated electricity.
