

Place UPS uninterruptible power supply in the power distribution room

Where should your uninterruptible power supply be located?

Your uninterruptible power supply (UPS) must be positioned somewhere safe, secure and accessible. In this article, we explore the fundamentals of UPS room layout and the things you need to consider when deciding where to locate your essential power protection systems.

How do you Power an uninterruptible power supply?

Planning how to power the loads from the uninterruptible power supply is an important exercise. Smaller single-phase UPS use rear panel IEC type connectors to which PDUs, or a UPS maintenance bypass switch can be connected. If a UPS maintenance bypass switch is installed the PDU and load connection may be via a sub-distribution board.

What is the critical power path in an ups installation?

The critical power path within a UPS installation runs from the loads connected to the power distribution units (PDUs) to the UPS that power the PDUs and to the UPS electrical supplies and potentially the building incomer. Planning how to power the loads from the uninterruptible power supply is an important exercise.

What is an uninterruptible power supply?

An uninterruptible power supply (UPS) is a device that provides power protection and back-up power when the mains power supply fails. It also protects from power problems when the mains power supply is present.

Does your server room or Datacentre need an UPS system?

Whether your server room or datacentre has single or three phase UPS systems, similar planning is required to ensure that the UPS is installed correctly and powers all the loads it is expected to. UPS systems even without their batteries are heavy and sometimes bulky items to transport.

How do I size a room for an uninterruptible power supply?

The most important factor in sizing a room for an Uninterruptible Power Supply is space around the equipment. You need to provide room for air to circulate and ventilation, as well as for manoeuvring around for maintenance and servicing.

All uninterruptible power supply batteries have a rated capacity which is determined based on specified conditions. The rated capacity of UPS batteries is based on an ambient temperature of 20°C or 25°C. Operating an uninterruptible power supply under these conditions will maximize the life of the UPS battery and result in optimal performance.

There are some key design considerations to be taken into account when installing a new UPS (Uninterruptible Power Supply).. 1. Single-Phase and Three-Phase Power. Many IT managers prefer to work with single-phase equipment at rack level, despite the temptation to focus on the bigger three-phase UPS systems.

Include all of the devices the UPS will need to support. If a piece of equipment has a redundant power supply, only count the wattage of ONE power supply. If you are unsure how many watts your equipment requires, consult the manufacturer or power supply specifications in the user manual. Here is an example of an equipment list to verify the load:
