Grounding serves as a critical safety mechanism to prevent electric shock, ensuring any fault currents are diverted safely.

What are the different types of power supply circuits?

The power supply circuits are classified into different types based on the power they utilize for providing for circuits or devices. For instance, the microcontroller based circuits are generally the 5V DC regulated power supply (RPS) circuits, which can be designed with the help of different method for changing the power from 230V AC to 5V DC.

Safety standards: The specific requirements that power supplies must meet to be considered safe. Key regulatory agencies: The organizations responsible for enforcing these safety standards. Compliance marks: The symbols or labels that indicate a power supply has passed safety testing.
