

When will 210mm p-type PV modules be discontinued?

Starting February 2025, the coverage of 210mm p-type modules will be discontinued. Prices for Chinese project will be prices for TOPCon modules instead of PERC from April 2024 onwards. InfoLink Consulting provides weekly updates on PV spot prices, covering module price, cell price, wafer price, and polysilicon price.

How long will PV Infolink take to become competitive?

PV Infolink predicts that it will take between two to three years of operation for new entrants to be competitive with established players like Chinese manufacturers in terms of capacity, yield rate, and purity. Cell, wafer, and module prices are also predicted to decrease.

How much does polysilicon cost?

Wafer (Per Pcs.) The mainstream concluded price for mono recharge polysilicon is RMB 41/KG, while mono dense polysilicon is priced at RMB 40/KG and N-type polysilicon is currently priced at RMB 38/KG. o Transaction Dynamics: This week, polysilicon manufacturers have been actively signing new orders.

How will polysilicon prices change in 2023?

The consulting firm expects prices to decline gradually through the first semester of 2023, followed by an accelerated decline in the second half of the year, with prices falling from the current CNY 300 (\$36.64)/kg to below CNY 150/kg by the end of 2023. Polysilicon production capacity may increase from 500 GW in 2022 to 975 GW next year.

What is the current inventory level of polysilicon?

o Inventory Dynamics: Current polysilicon inventory levels are estimated at around 260,000-280,000 tons. Following the recent surge in installation demand, polysilicon manufacturers intend to maintain high operating rates to accelerate inventory reduction.

Cell, wafer, and module prices are also predicted to decrease. PV Infolink expects cell pricing to be roughly \$0.16/W through 2022 and fall slowly next year to around \$0.10/W by year-end. It puts current pricing for a 210 mm mono wafer at around \$0.21/W, which could fall to around \$0.13/W by end 2023.

This year, polysilicon prices have stayed on an upward trend, as short supply persists due to mismatched production capacities in up and downstream and long construction time that new polysilicon production capacities take. Weekly spot price table will be adjusted to reflect this starting in June. Cell prices continued to decrease this week, reaching RMB 0.31-0.32/W for p-type M10 cells and RMB 0.33-0.34/W for G12 ones. Given declines in wafer prices, prices kept falling to RMB 0.32-0.34/W for M10 TOPCon cells and RMB 0.55-0.6/W for G12 HJT high-efficiency cells.

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Price Trend: In China's centralized utility-scale solar PV market, price quotes for 182mm to 210mm TOPCon modules have stabilized at around RMB 0.69/W. Meanwhile, distributed solar system module prices declined to RMB 0.730/W this week. Bifacial M10 TOPCon modules: Leading manufacturers are quoting in the RMB 0.66-0.75/W range.

In India, prices for local modules will average at USD 0.2-0.24/W. In Europe, spot prices begin to level off at EUR 0.11-0.135/W. As demand switches from PERC products, prices for TOPCon n-type modules come in at RMB 1.05-1.22/W, with a premium of USD 0.005-0.008/W against PERC ones in non-China markets.

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
