



RV outdoor power supply parameters

What kind of power does an RV use?

When you're plugged into shore power at a campground or home, your RV is getting its electricity from an external source - usually a large box on the ground near your campsite. This is called a pedestal, and it has three types of electrical outlets in it: a 30 amp plug, a 50 amp plug, and a 120 volt AC outlet.

Do you need a 120 volt power source for a camper?

You must have a 120-volt AC power source to use the microwave, roof air conditioner, the refrigerator in the AC mode, the 120-volt electrical outlets, and any other 120-volt appliances or components in the RV. For the most part, everything else in the camper works on 12-volt DC or battery power.

How do you plug an RV power cord into a campground?

Most campgrounds you stay at provide you with an external 120-volt electrical source to plug the RV power cord into. Your RV has a heavy-duty power cord that is roughly 20 feet long, so it can reach the campground pedestal. Depending on the type of RV you have, or purchase, it will either have a 30-amp or 50-amp electrical system.

What is the electrical system of a motorhome?

The electrical system of a motorhome can be quite complex, involving 12 volt DC battery power as well as 120 volt AC power. It's unavoidable that issues will occur from time to time but many of these can easily be corrected by the RV owner with a basic understanding of electricity.

Does 120 volt AC work at RV campgrounds?

The 120 volt AC power only works when plugged into shore power at a campground or when running a generator. This is where amperage comes in. There are two different types of plugs at RV campgrounds: 30 amp and 50 amp. Most RVers will have a 30 amp rig, but if you have a 50 amp rig, it means your RV can pull more power from the campground.

RV shore power refers to the electrical connection that allows your RV to draw power from an external source, typically at a campsite or RV park. This connection provides a stable supply of electricity for your RV's ...
