

Romanian government's 600 million energy storage project

How much money will Romania provide for battery energy storage systems?

The Ministry of Energy of Romania will provide just over EUR103 million in financial support for battery energy storage system (BESS) deployments in the country. Minister of Energy Virgil Popescu signed an order approving the state aid scheme for investments in battery energy storage systems on Monday, 28 November, announced via his Facebook page.

Does Romania have a grant program for battery energy storage systems?

The Romanian Ministry of Energy has launched a grant program for battery energy storage systems developed in conjunction with existing renewable energy facilities - wind, solar, or hydro. Romania has launched a new subsidy scheme for behind-the-meter battery energy storage systems to the tune of EUR 150 million (\$158 million).

What is Enery doing in Romania?

This week, Vienna-based Enery has commissioned a major solar and storage site in northwestern Romania. The project consists of a 51.4 MW PV plant and a battery energy storage facility of 22 MWh.

What is Romania's most important energy project?

Earlier this month, Burduja reported progress on what he terms as "the most important project for the Romanian energy system" - the 1 GW Tarnișoara pumped storage hydropower plant. Romania resumed the development of the project last year, upping the planned capacity from 500 MW to 1 GW.

What are the key investment contracts for Romania's energy security?

The Minister of Energy, Sebastian Burduja, signed today, November 4, 2024, several key investment contracts for Romania's energy security. Five projects signed today support energy storage in batteries, part of the PNRR/2022/C6/M ENERGIE Call for Projects, and contribute a total capacity of 791.48 MWh.

Will pnrr help Romania meet its energy needs?

Earlier in November, the Ministry of Energy allocated EUR 30 million in non-reimbursable support via PNRR for 791.48 MWh of battery energy storage. Once delivered, the five projects will see Romania meet 20% of its storage needs, according to the ministry's announcement.

The project will have a power rating of 127MW and an energy storage capacity of 254MWh and, while it is one of the larger announced in Romania, R.Power didn't say when it would come online (the largest we've reported on, by far, is a 2GWh project from another IPP, Monsson)..
