How much money did San Diego spend on energy storage projects?

In particular, the budget provided \$18 million to the city of San Diego and the San Diego County Water Authority for use in advancing their planned joint project known as the San Vicente Energy Storage Facility.

How much energy can a San Vicente energy storage facility store?

Ultimately, the San Vicente Energy Storage Facility could store as much as 500 MWh of capacity for eight hours, or the equivalent of 4,000 MWh per day of energy, according to a project fact sheet from the city and the SDCWA. "When operating, the project will provide enough energy for about 135,000 households," the fact sheet states.

How much battery storage does SDG&E have?

SDG&E's utility-owned battery storage portfolio is expected to reach nearly 480 MWh of power capacity and over 1.9 GWh of energy storage by year-end, including the Westside Canal expansion and two additional projects in San Diego County currently being constructed.

The San Diego battery facility came online in 2020 and was billed at the time by grid infrastructure developer LS Power as the largest battery energy storage project in the world. Using LG Chem Lithium-ion cells, it beat the previous record held by a 150MW project in Australia, although has since been surpassed by other facilities.
