How many Watts Does a solar light need?

Working with the solar lighting specialist can help determine the requirements needed for light output. For example, signs can be illuminated with a range from a 3.4 Watt FLAB mini flood for small signs to up to 25 Watt ARF flood fixtures for large signs and billboard applications. The same thing can be said for overhead lights.

How many watts does an overhead light need?

The same thing can be said for overhead lights. Small pedestrian pathways can use either bollard fixtures or overhead fixtures and are usually between 15 and 25 Watts or 1400 and 2600 Lumens and are installed low. Higher lighting requirements of highways and parking lots start around 25 Watts / 2600 Lumens and go up to 70 Watts / 6500 Lumens.

Watts indicate how much energy a bulb consumes. With traditional bulbs, higher watts meant brighter light. However, with LEDs, less energy (fewer watts) is needed for a higher light output. 3. As a rule of thumb, this implies a rough ratio of 7:1 when choosing an LED bulb to replace an incandescent bulb. For example, suppose you wish to replace a 100-watt incandescent bulb with an equivalent LED bulb. Utilizing the 7:1 ratio, you can estimate the wattage by dividing 100 watts by 7, resulting in roughly 14 watts for the LED bulb.

A typical 300-watt solar panel is 65.8 inches long and 36.1 inches wide. It takes up 16.5 sq ft of area. If you have a 1000 sq ft roof, and you can use 75% of that roof area for solar panels, you can theoretically put 45 300-watt solar panels on a 1000 sq ft roof. A typical 400-watt solar panel is 79.1 inches long and 39.1 inches wide.

This means $1000 \text{ watts} \times 80 \text{ lumens} = 80,000 \text{ lumens}$. This shows that a 1,000-watt LED bulb would give off around 80,000 lumens. By comparison, a traditional incandescent bulb would only produce around 15,000 lumens while consuming the same amount of power. Example lumen to watt conversion.
