How long does a solar panel warranty last?

The length of a product warranty varies based on the manufacturer and model. Traditionally, these warranties typically last 10-15 years, although it is becoming more common for premium panels to have 20 and 25 year product warranties. If a panel fails within the warranty period, the manufacturer will typically replace or refund the panel.

What is a performance warranty on a solar panel?

A performance warranty guarantees a maximum level of degradation- typically between .25% and .75% - per year so that in 25 years the panel will still have 80-90% of the power output it did in its first year. Performance warranties are important for sizing solar systems to maintain 100% offset for 25 years.

Do you need a solar panel warranty?

A solar panel warranty is important to have, but it won't do much good unless you can monitor your system and identify issues. You may be able to identify larger issues, such as cracking, with the naked eye. But performance issues are most easily identified through a digital system monitoring app or web portal.

How long do solar panels last?

For that, industry standard is 20-25 years, with selected glass-glass module manufacturers even providing 30 years. Within this period, the under-performing solar panels will be replaced, or the owner gets compensated for the associated losses.

How long does a solar inverter last?

Within this period, the under-performing solar panels will be replaced, or the owner gets compensated for the associated losses. On the other hand, solar inverters are more complex and hence have shorter warranty periods of 5 to 12 years. However, as solar inverters are easily accessible, they can be swapped out when required.
