What are the different solar technologies in Spain?

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Is Spain a leader in concentrated solar power?

Since 2010, Spain has been the world's leader in concentrated solar power (CSP). Spain is leapfrogged by Italy during 2011 following a later solar boom there to lose its position as the world's second largest installer of solar PV.

How much solar power does Spain have?

In 2010, Spain maintained approximately 10 percent of global installed capacity share. About 10 percent of the country's energy comes from solar power, two percent higher than the average for most countries.

Spain's total wind generation capacity, its prime renewable source in recent years, has doubled since 2008. Solar energy capacity, meanwhile, has increased by a factor of eight over the same period.

Spain is a world leader in installed power. With 1,265 wind farms (21,419 turbines) installed in 1037 municipalities, wind power is the first ranking renewable in Spain's energy mix, followed by hydroelectric in 2021. Business environment.
