With domestic policy incentives and scale effects, China has become a prominent actor in the global PV trade as well as a deep victim of PV trade frictions, which has dramatically reshaped the pattern of China's PV trade.

The dispute over solar panels traces its roots back to 2007, when the Chinese government announced its Medium-and Long-Term Plan for Renewable Energy Development, with the intention of making the solar panel sector a pillar industry. To this end, several internal electrification projects were launched.

In April, a coalition of U.S. photovoltaics manufacturers petitioned the Department of Commerce to impose anti-dumping tariffs on solar panels from four Southeast Asian countries. The move is the latest in a long history of solar trade disputes involving China and, more recently, Chinese PV manufacturers operating throughout Asia.

However, China has not always dominated the solar PV supply chain, and Europe had been the frontrunner in the "solar revolution". In 2007, 30 % of PV manufacturing was still located in Europe. In an attempt to protect the industry, the European Commission, in 2013, proposed a phased anti-dumping tariff on solar PV panels imported from China.
