Water heating accounts for an average of 18% of the total energy used in the household, or around 162 kWh per month. On a normal day, a water heater runs for around 2 to 3 hours a day, which means that it will consume roughly 4-5 kWh of electricity a day. Heat pump water heaters are more efficient and can run on around 2.5 kWh per day. But power outages ...

During a power outage, the solar component of the heater will continue to function as long as there is sunlight. However, if your system relies on an electric pump to circulate the water, it may not operate without power.
