The Somali government has kicked off a tender for the design, supply, installation, testing and commissioning of a 55 MW solar plant with a 160 MWh battery energy storage system (BESS) in Mogadishu.

The project was initiated by the utility National Energy Corporation of Somalia (NECSOM), with the first phase completed and connected in February 2016. The microgrid at that time added 1MW of solar PV generation capacity and 1.4MWh of energy storage to diesel gensets already in use at the site.
