

Is solar energy a viable option for Spain's future energy demand?

How will Spain's new solar policy affect the energy sector?

The Spanish Photovoltaic Union (UNEF, Madrid) estimates that under the new policy roughly 30% of solar photovoltaic (PV) projects will suffer cuts around 40% to expected income, which will make owners unable to meet debt payments. Additionally, the law removes the priority for renewable energy on Spain's grid, in violation of EU law.

Are solar panels eco-friendly in Spain?

It means the carbon footprint of manufacturing 16 solar panels is equivalent to the carbon footprint of 3 kWh in Spain - most detached homes here will consume 3 kWh by midday in a single day.
