

Spanish wind power storage

How long do wind turbines last in Spain?

Every third wind turbine currently operating in Spain was installed before 2005 and the lifespan of wind turbines generating electricity is about 20 to 25 years--far less than the 40 to 60 year life of coal, gas and nuclear plants.

Will Spain double its wind power?

Spain's new government goal to double wind capacity means it would need to almost triple wind installations from current annual rates. Because of a shorter life span than fossil fuel and nuclear plants, over one third of Spain's wind turbines must be replaced within 5 years.

How many wind farms are there in Spain?

Spain has one of the most developed wind industries in the world, integrating almost the entire supply chain from manufacturing of the turbines and the operation of more than 1,345 wind farms in 850 municipalities.

Will Spain raise its share of renewables by 2030?

According to a draft government report issued in June, Spain's goal is to raise the share of renewables to four-fifths by 2030. The new climate plan includes higher targets for solar and wind power capacity as well as energy storage.

Does Spain still generate more electricity from renewable sources?

Spain continues to generate more electricity from renewable sources as its renewable share of electricity rose to 50.8 percent in 2023 from 42.2 percent in 2022. According to a draft government report issued in June, Spain's goal is to raise the share of renewables to four-fifths by 2030.

What will Spain's energy plan entail in 2025?

The draft government plan also contains the phase-out of nuclear energy and speeds up Spain's exit from coal, now set for 2025. Spain is pushing renewables despite a 3 percent reduction in energy demand last year due to higher capital costs and energy efficiency measures.
