The junction box's standard size starts from 4" x 4 inches. Imagine a cross-junction with horizontal and vertical straight pulls of wires from 1/2-inch conduits to 1/2-inch conduits. According to the 2020 National Electrical Code, the length of a junction box must be at least eight times the largest conduit for straight pulls.
