

Taipei Government Photovoltaic Energy Storage

What is Taipei City doing with solar energy?

Taipei City has also set a target of solar PV installation to reach 66MW by 2030. In addition, the City introduces smart micro power grid systems that integrate solar PV and energy storage equipment in social housing, campuses and government agencies, to increase renewable energy use and build the foundation for energy transition.

What is the solar Taipei program?

Through the Solar Taipei Program, the city is promoting the installation of photovoltaic systems through public-private partnerships, with a goal of 66MW by 2030. Complementing this, Taipei is introducing smart micro-grid systems that integrate photovoltaic systems and energy storage equipment in social housing, campuses, and government agencies.

What is solar Taipei?

Apart from this, Taipei City actively seeks to expand civic participation in the development and use of renewable energy. By launching the "Solar Taipei Program", the City promotes the set up of solar PV systems through public-private partnership.

How big is Taipei City's solar power plant?

In 2020, the City collaborated with the citizen interest group Homemakers United Foundation to build Taiwan's largest civic power plant with a capacity of 19.8 kW at Guandu Junior High School. Taipei City has also set a target of solar PV installation to reach 66MW by 2030.

How energy storage system works in Taiwan?

The energy storage system can discharge power immediately to fill any power gaps, and its hour of duration provides enough time for all the natural gas units across Taiwan to start up and restore power. It is anticipated that similar energy storage facilities will be gradually established throughout Taiwan in the coming years.

Can Taiwan achieve a solar photovoltaic installation capacity by 2025?
