What is Germany's electricity storage capacity?

They still make up the largest share of the electricity storage capacity in Germany; about 30 projects commissioned between 1926 and 2004 provide a total capacity of about 7 GW. The majority are operated by utilities and they principally provide time-shifted electricity supply and balancing energy.

When was kW Moorburg built?

Project-level coal details The Hamburg-Moorburg power station, or KW Moorburg, was proposed in 2004 by its sponsoring company, Vattenfall, and approved internally in 2006. Construction began in 2007 on the site of the previous Moorburg gas power plant, which was demolished in 2004.
