What is the biggest power plant in the world?

The world's biggest power plant is the Three Gorges Dam in China. In 2021, it generated 103.649 billion kWh. It's followed by the Itaipu Dam in Brazil (the previous record holder for most power generated). Which is the largest hydropower plant in the world?

Topping the list is the Three Gorges Hydroelectric power plant. It is considered the world's largest hydropower plant. The power station has 32 turbines of 700MW each as well as two 50MW power generators. It is located in one of the three gorges of the Yangtze River with an estimated annual energy output of 85TWh.

Which power plant produces the most electricity in a year?

The Itaipu Dam plant held the previous world record for most power generated in a year. It's on the border between Brazil and Paraguay, on the Paraná River. In 2021, it generated 66.369 billion kWh, but it set the world record in 2016 with 103.098 billion kWh. It's the world's second biggest power plant.

What is the largest underground power station in the world?

With an installed capacity of 5 616 MW, it is the largest power station owned by Hydro Quebec. This also makes it the largest underground power station in the world. The Robert-Bourassa HPP is located underground about 6 km downstream of the main dam. Annually the plant generates about 26,500 GWh.
