Do I need a manual to ship lithium batteries?

Can I ship a lithium battery internationally?

Lithium batteries are classified as Dangerous Goods and not all types are accepted by DHL Express. There are regulations attached to the cross-border shipping of batteries, including lithium batteries, to ensure they travel safely. These regulations vary depending on the type of batteries.

What are the shipping requirements for lithium batteries?

Shippers are also required to take into account other dangerous goods that may be shipped with lithium batteries to ensure that there is no incompatibility. Such as not packing lithium batteries with flammable liquids in the same package or overpack. It is essential to follow the net quantity limits when shipping lithium batteries.

What type of packaging do you need for lithium ion batteries?

Depending on the Watt-hour rating for lithium ion cells or batteries or the lithium metal content for lithium metal cells or batteries, the packaging required may need to be UN specification or may be simply strong, rigid packaging that is strong enough to withstand the shocks, mechanical handling, and loading encountered in transport.
