Does Britain import or export electricity?

Gross electricity imports and exports as a share of British electricity demand each quarter. For decades, Britain has imported more electricity than it exported, as neighbouring France has plentiful cheap nuclear power.

What percentage of UK electricity is imported?

Imports had the third biggest share of the electricity mix in six of the last nine months. June saw the highest ever proportion of imported electricity to Britain, making up 19% of the mix, with gas at 20%. Since January 2020, the UK has been a net exporter of electricity in seven out of 58 months.

How much of Britain's electricity supply is powered by foreign energy imports?

Last year, just under half of Britain's electricity supply was powered by foreign energy imports, said researchers at the Energy and Climate Intelligence Unit (ECIU), down from 65% in 2014.

Which country imports the most electricity to the UK?

Nuclear from France is the leading source of imported electricity to the UK. Net electricity imports from France to the UK totalled 12.7 TWh last year according to government data, and France's grid is made up of around 70% nuclear. Norway is the second largest exporter of power to the UK, mainly from hydro.

NIA Chief Executive The UK has imported a record amount of electricity from Europe in 2024 to help meet the country's power demand, new analysis by the Nuclear Industry Association (NIA) has found.

UK power prices also remain higher than those in interconnected neighbouring countries, incentivising power imports into the UK. Although the UK is currently a net importer of electricity, with further increases in a clean power system it is projected to become a net exporter of power by 2030, reversing the existing traditional power flows.

Overall, the cost of electricity imports expanded by an average 121.6% for all importing countries since 5 years earlier in 2019 when international purchases of electricity were valued at \$32.2 billion. ... The gap between imports and exports has increased since 2004. In 2017 UK imports of energy were almost twice as large as its exports. Net imports made up 36% of UK energy needs. In the same year the value of gross imports of energy of £45 billion or £18 billion more than gross exports. Gas and oil make up around 90% of energy imports.

The UK is on track to import a record amount of electricity in 2024, smashing the previous record from 2021 by 50%. According to Nuclear Industry Association analysis of National Grid Electricity System Operator (ESO) data, net electricity imports to Great Britain totalled a record 9 TWh in the first quarter of 2024, and 14.95 TWh from January through the end of May.
