What is an Uninterruptible Power Supply (UPS)?

An Uninterruptible Power Supply (UPS) is a system that converts kinetic energy from a flywheel into electrical energy to power electrical equipment. It is also referred to as a battery backup or a standby power system. A standard interface for synchronous and asynchronous communications up to 20 kb/s between two compatible devices (one driver and one receiver) over distances of up to 15m.

Why do I need a UPS system?

This allows your equipment to stay on during a power outage, which is especially useful for devices like computers that can lose data when they turn off unexpectedly. Note: A UPS system can also be called an uninterruptible power supply or battery backup system. Why do I need a UPS?

How long does it take a ups to activate backup power?

This usually means that a UPS system must be capable of activating backup power within 25ms of a power loss. A UPS is, by nature, redundant. This means that it provides an important protective barrier against data loss, outages, and expensive hardware damage (by smoothing out voltage anomalies).

How do I choose a ups for power backup?

The load size, location and criticality of the equipment to be protected are key, as well as budgetary considerations, when choosing a UPS for power backup. The three major types of UPS system configurations are online double conversion, line-interactive and offline (also called standby and battery backup).

What happens if you lose power on a UPS system?

In case of power loss, the UPS system immediately activates to provide a continuous power source. The battery backup gives you time to power down sensitive equipment, servers, or even gaming consoles without loss of data or progress. UPS systems also provide protection from other power problems that arise.

How long do UPS batteries last?

In a telecom or data center environment, however, the batteries of a UPS may last for several hours or more. If commercial power failures are most likely expected to be rare and brief, a UPS may be the only backup power source at a remote site. However, at least one diesel or propane generator can also be present to provide backup power.
