What is the energy sector like in Uzbekistan?

In Uzbekistan, the energy sector is concentrated in the hands of two monopolies, Uzbekenergo and Uzbekneftegaz, with mineral resources and rare-earth minerals concentrated at metallurgy plants, which the government intends to upgrade through a number of sponsored programmes, and with the active assistance of foreign contractors and suppliers.

How many hydroelectric power plants will be built in Uzbekistan?

In February 2022, Uzbekistan's Ministry of Energy announced that in accordance with its development strategy for the period of 2022-2026, 15 new hydroelectric power plants (HPPs) with a total capacity of 868 MW would be constructed in the country in addition to the modernization of five more existing HPPs.

What is Voltalia doing in Uzbekistan?

November 2022- Voltalia signed an agreement with the Uzbek government to co-develop between 400-500 MW of renewable energy projects in Uzbekistan, which includes the development of 200 MW of solar, 200 MW of wind, and 60 MW/240 MWh of battery storage power.

What is happening in Tajikistan and Uzbekistan?

In June 2022, Tajikistan and Uzbekistan started building two hydropower plants on the Zarafshan River. The first stage was the construction of the 140 MW Yavan hydroelectric station, estimated at USD 282 million, designed to generate 700-800 million kWh annually.
