What is energy storage Ireland?

How many GW of electricity does Ireland have?

ESB Networks also recently announced that Ireland's electricity grid now has 1 gigawatt (GW), or 1,000 MW, of electricity storage connected to Ireland's network. This figure includes 731.5 MW of battery energy storage system projects and 292 MW from Turlough Hill pumped storage power station.

What is energy storage?

Energy storage is the counterweight to intermittent renewable generation capacity, such as wind and solar power, and enables balancing of the energy system by matching supply and demand.
