Do I need a travel adapter for a Moldova Charger?

Can I connect my laptop charger to an electrical outlet in Moldova?

Yes, you can connect your laptop charger to an electrical outlet in Moldova as long as the outlet is compatible with the charger's voltage and plug type. In Moldova, the standard voltage is 220V and the standard frequency is 50Hz.

What is the standard voltage for power sockets in Moldova?
