Power outlets aren't always safe in Cuba, so always approach with caution when plugging and unplugging your devices. Also, a fuse protected power adapter is advised. What kind of power adapter do I need for Cuba? Type A/B is the North American-style twin rectangular prongs.

Do I need a power adapter for Cuba?

If you're visiting Cuba from the United States, you should bring a power adapter as US Type A or B outlets may not be readily available. However, if your device runs on 110 volts or is dual voltage, and the plug fits in a Cuban power outlet, it will work without a plug adapter.

What type of power plug is used in Cuba?

In Cuba, power plugs and sockets (outlets) of type A, type B, type C and type L are used. The standard voltage is 110 / 220 V at a frequency of 60 Hz. Cuba, a Caribbean island nation, is known for its vibrant culture, stunning beaches, and fascinating history.

Cuba operates on a 110/220V supply voltage and 60Hz. Although the power supply in Cuba is mainly 110V, some of the newer hotels operate at 220V. Electricity supplies worldwide can vary from anything between 100V and 240V. For Cuba there are four associated plug types, types A, B, C and L.
