What power plugs are used in Portugal?

In Portugal, power plugs and sockets (outlets) of type F are used. The standard voltage is 230 V at a frequency of 50 Hz. For more information, select the country you live in at the top of this page. What voltage is a power socket in Portugal?

The power sockets in Portugal are of type F. The standard voltage is 230 V at a frequency of 50 Hz. Check your need for a power plug (travel) adapter in Portugal.

Do I need a power adapter in Portugal?

If your devices are compatible with these specifications, you will not need a power adapter. However, if your devices use a different plug type or are not compatible with the voltage in Portugal, you will need a power adapter and/or a voltage converter/transformer. The standard voltage in Portugal is 230 V, and the standard frequency is 50 Hz.

What is the voltage in Portugal?

Just like the rest of Europe, the voltage in Portugal is 230 volts and the frequency is 50 Hz. Portugal has standardized on type F sockets and plugs. Type C and type E plugs can also be used thanks to their compatibility with type F sockets.

Are there electrical outlets in Portugal?

No, the electrical outlets in Portugal are different from those in the United States. In Portugal, electrical outlets of types C & F are used, while the United States has electrical outlets of types A & B. Do I need a travel adapter for Portugal? The electrical outlets and power plugs in Portugal are of types C & F (see images).

What type of AC plugs are used in Portugal?

AC plugs and sockets in Portugal include Type C and Type F. Type F is the Schuko plug with two round pins of 4.8 mm in diameter. The pins are 19 mm long and 19 mm apart. There are two contact areas at the top and bottom of the plug for earth. Type C is similar but without the earth contacts. The common Europlug fits this kind of socket.

All power sockets in Portugal provide a standard voltage of 230V with a standard frequency of 50Hz. You can use all your equipment in Portugal if the outlet voltage in your own country is ...

The electrical outlets in Portugal are the same as those in neighboring Spain: Type C and Type F. They both have two round holes, but Type F also has two grounding clips, while Type C is ungrounded. In Lisbon and throughout Portugal, Type F tends to be the more common outlet type. Type C and Type F plugs are



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interchangeable, meaning both can take either plug ...

It is not recommended to bring electrical appliances with a motor from the USA (appliances such as refrigerators, electric can openers, and stereos). The voltage in the US is 110 and 60 hertz, while in Portugal it is 220 volts and 50 hertz. The appliances would need a transformer.
