Choosing a strengthened glass is also beneficial because it will make your space open and airy even if it's a small sunroom. Tinted glass brings natural light but of course not the sun-heat!

How much does a glass sunroom cost?

For a three-season sunroom, the materials may cost you around \$6,000-\$35,000, and if you wish to install a four-season glass sunroom, you may have to spend above \$15,000 on materials only. Better End! A glass sunroom may seem expensive, but it enhances the exterior decor aesthetics and increases the security from pests and other allergies.

What is a good U-value for a sunroom?

The typical U-value is 1.6. If you can't build your sunroom in the location that will keep it the most comfortable, or you want more hours to enjoy your all-season room, consider these options: Add operative skylights to act as heat dumps when the room gets too warm. Intersperse prefabricated insulating roof panels among the glass roof panels.

Is double-paned glass suitable for a sunroom?

For a homeowner in a mild climate, double-paned glass may be sufficient to keep a sunroom comfortable. However, tinted glass, which has many of the heat-reducing benefits of Low-E coating, also dims the light that comes into the sunroom.
